







2nd Workshop – Latin America

24-26 September 2013

Bogotá, Colombia

The 2nd of the three anchor workshops will be held in Bogotá and will focus on the optimization of water infrastructure to meet growing water, energy and food needs. The workshop will use a highly-interactive process in which you will be asked to share your 'best-practice' success stories in water infrastructure operation, optimization, financing and governance, while creating a shared, cross-sectoral vision that combines best available technology, know-how and experiences.

The objectives of the Bogotá workshop include:

-  To develop a better understanding amongst participants to combine and apply best practices on water, energy and food nexus based approach for solutions in river basins;
-  To identify best-practice success stories in water infrastructure operation, optimization, financing and governance;
-  To motivate participants to take practical steps towards implementing water, energy and food nexus thinking and practices in their basins; and
-  Help facilitate the creation of new coalitions and partnerships for follow-up actions.
